Characteristic of the goods:

The Rwenzori Mountains of the Moon Coffee has a uniform clean cup and a strong personality characterized by its sweetness, very fruity aroma, chocolate flavor and smooth medium body, mild citric acidity with frequent dried fruits after taste. The product is Rwenzori Mountains of the Moon Coffee which is an Arabica coffee of varieties SL14 and SL28, cultivated on the slopes of the Rwenzori Mountain at an altitude of over 1200m asl in agroforestry system (shaded) with trees without use of chemicals or synthetic fertilizers. At the altitude of 1200m asl and above, coffee when cupped scores 80 points and above out of 100 at cupping is produced. Rwenzori Mountains of the Moon coffee has only two varieties; SL 14 and SL28 which have well recognized cup profile linked to the high quality at high altitude of at least 1200 metres above sea level where it is produced on the slopes of Rwenzori Mountain with agroforestry shade trees. The area is crossed with the equator line that its influence gives a balanced warm, hot and cool weather throughout the year which allows natural bean formation and growth of the coffee with annual average temperatures ranging from 18°C to 23 °C and annual average rainfall pattern is within 970mm to 1600mm as observed from data from 1970 to 2000 (WorldClim. org). The coffee is planted with shade trees and intercrops like bananas. Red ripe coffee cherries are selectively picked during harvesting time and milled to parchment within a day. Coffee farmers grow the coffee by applying climate smart agricultural practices which helps to

maintain the unique intrinsic quality.

The geographical indication will strictly be used in relation to "coffee only" and by

persons within the delimited geographical area who comply with the code of practice.

Geographical area:

The districts covered in the delimited area include; Kasese, Kabarole, Bunyangabo, Ntoroko and Bundibugyo. The area was demarcated according to the different grade sizes that produce high quality coffee of AA, A and B that score 80 points and above out of 100 during cupping for GI qualification which is recognized by the market and locally defined by UCDA from the National Coffee Act, 2021. The delimited geographical area lies at an altitude level of 1200m above sea level and above which produces coffee that scores at least 80 points and above, except between Rwimi Town and Karago where it follows the road: Rwimi, Kibiito, Mugusu, Fort Portal, Bukuuku, and Karago. The delimited area include part of the districts Kasese, Kabarole, Bunyangabu, Ntoroko and Bundibugyo.
